



How does the Houston SPCA help pets and people?

We have an ambulance for hurt animals, 24 hours a day.



We help animals without food, water, shelter, or medical care (visits to Veterinarian when they are sick or hurt).



We help unwanted pets find new families.



We give dogs and cats:

Tags, so they don't get lost,
Shots, so they don't get sick, and

Spay or Neuter surgery, so they don't have puppies or kittens (to help with the problem of too many pets).



We help animals in disasters, like floods.



We teach grown ups and children to care for pets and to be respectful & kind to all living creatures.



We help pet owners find lost pets.



We have a store with pet supplies that raises money for the shelter animals.



We give shelter to all animals, we never turn any animal away.



Pet Safety Tips:

- **Always** move slow and quiet around animals. Loud noises can scare them.
- **Never** run from an animal (they will chase you). Walk away slowly with your hands in your pockets and **don't** make eye contact.
- **Don't** touch an animal that is tied up or in a cage. They may bite!
- **Don't** touch an animal that is eating, sleeping, or caring for babies.
