



Project Ideas for Kids & Teens

- Donation Drive for pet supplies, litter, toys, treats, etc.
- Stuffed Animal Drive - for puppies in shelter and mobile adoptions
- Making Doggie Cookies or cat treats*
- Making Cat Nip Toys (material with a cotton ball and cat nip inside, tied up with a ribbon)
- Making Cat Scratch Posts
- Make Horse Treats*
- Make Hamster Houses, Guinea Pig Garages, or Rat Retreats (made with craft sticks, non-toxic glue, tunnels of toilet paper rolls, and lots of creativity!)
- Make Gift Bags filled with treats, toys, grooming supplies, coupons, etc. for new adopters (cats or dogs)
- Make Bird toys - with ropes, bells, etc.
- Sponsor a dog or cat - make a resume, take a picture, make copies and hand out flyers to get pet adopted
- Make cat beds - 1/2 pillowcase and stuff with old T-shirts or towels
- Make cat toys with feathers or puff balls tied to ribbons to dangle on cages
- Collecting pet food, treat, supply coupons from the newspapers to give out to new adopters

Fundraisers

- Car Wash or Garage Sale to benefit shelter animals
- Doggie Wash - like a car wash, but for dogs, can also educate public about responsible pet care and grooming.
- Pennies for Pets - collect coins (great for schools!)
- Walking neighborhood dogs or pet sitting
- Bake Sale - for people OR pets, setting up at local store or even at the shelter
- Make ornaments to sell at shelter to put on SPCA tree during holidays
- Join the HSPCA Mutt Strut & Runway Race- a walk for dogs to raise funds
